



USTC Sailability Coordinator

- The Urunga Sail Training Club (USTC) and including Sailability Urunga is a "Family" orientated Not-for-profit community organization teaching sailing and other water related activities for all ages with Social Sailing most Sundays from about 9.30am to 2.30pm.
- We can insure any person between the ages of 5 and 85 to participate in our "On Water" activities. No age is too young or old to be involved in the clubs variety of activities, as they are not all on the water, including our monthly "Kid Friendly Full Moon BBQ's".
- We have a great space to run around, accessible ramps, toilets and shower, a big fireplace for toasting marshmallows and a good kitchen. And yes, we even have a high chair and baby change table!
- Located just East of the Urunga railway bridge on the right hand corner of Bellingen and River Streets, (the big BLUE building) the USTC is an accredited Yachting Australia (YA) *Discover Sailing Training Centre* where we teach the nationally recognised YA Dinghy Sailing courses for ages from about 9 to 70 irrespective of skill and ability.

- Access to existing documentation and advertising material.
- Anything we can afford to provide if required and we have the finances or a sponsor.
